




A wonder that has been crafted in Markana, the Victoria Memorial is a slice of pure nostalgia from the city of Kolkata.

The Victoria Memorial is much more than an iconic landmark or historical building in the city of Joy, Kolkata, West Bengal. Made out of the white Markana marble, this magnificent monument stands as a reminder of the city's colonial and architectural style.

This monument features the Indo-Saracenic revivalist architectural style which displays a blend of Mughal and British elements along with Egyptian, Islamic, Venetian, and Deccani elements. In terms of design, it draws inspiration from the Taj Mahal. The monument has a main central dome, four smaller domes, high portals, domed chaatris of octagonal shape, domed towers at the corners, and terrace.
