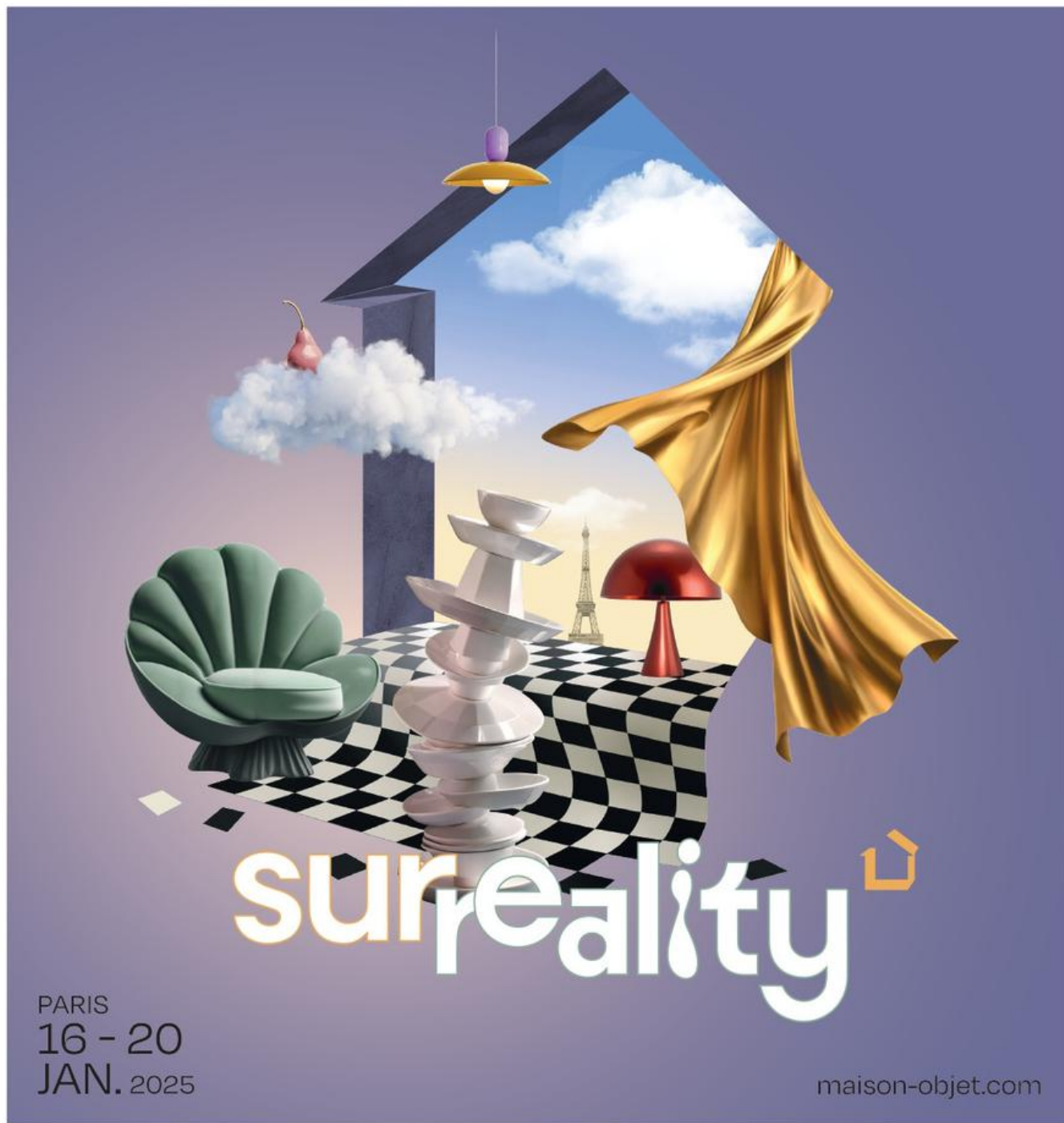

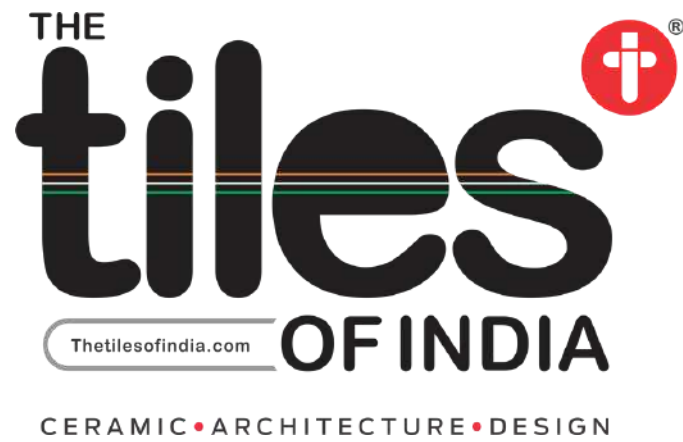
BUILDING GEOMETRY
